The new arrangement seeks to realign and rotate the football pitch to accommodate two goals whilst creating dedicated space for other users. An accessible path, dotted with a range of benches, markings and trees allows all users to access the space with ease, fun and comfort on both foot and on wheels!

New play equipment has been included to appeal to a wide range of users of different ages and abilities and playful landforms will provide additional play opportunities whilst serving as an effective division between the two halves of the space.

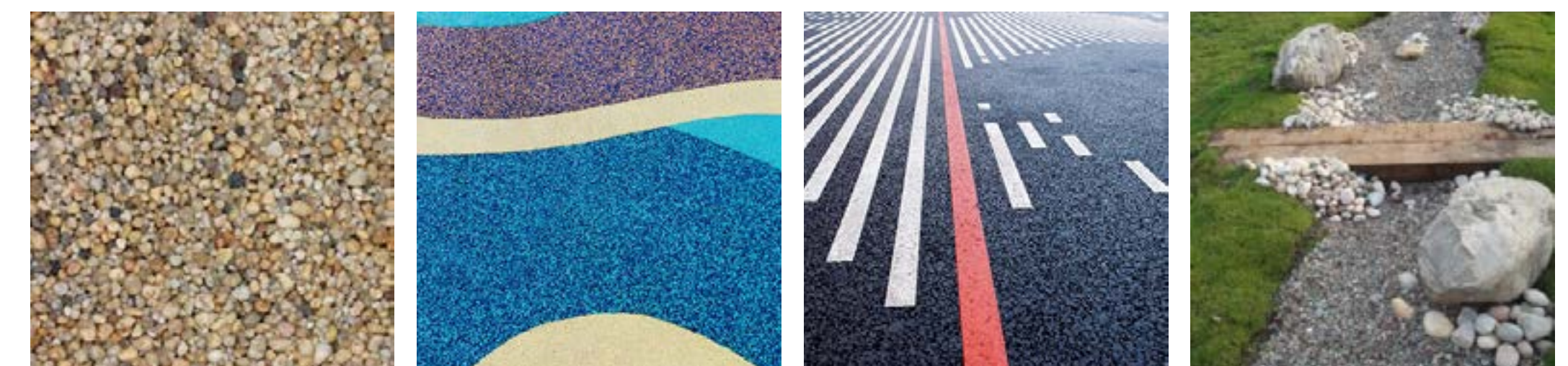
